

Pink and White Acrylic Sculptured Nails

1. Both me and my client washed and sanitized our hands.
2. I prepped the nails by pushing back the cuticles, roughing up the nails using a medium grit file and shaping the free edge.
3. I applied dehydrator and primer to all 10 nails.
4. I placed a form on each nail and sculpted the white free edge using white perfect powder and shaped a deep smile line pinching the form to make a deeper c-curve on all 10 nails. I then removed the forms.
5. I used ultra natural perfect powder and formed moons on all 10 nails.
6. I used pink perfect powder on the rest of the nail bed.
7. I shaped all 10 nails using a heavy grit file.
8. I smoothed all 10 nails using a finer file.
9. I buffed all 10 nails using an orange buffer.
10. I applied cuticle oil to all 10 nails.
11. I buffed all 10 nails to a shine with a 3-way buffer.
12. We washed our hands.
13. I took the presentation shot.
14. I applied base coat, 2 coats of you make me vroom red cream polish and top coat to 2 nails.
15. I took the close up and down the barrel shots.

I used a 5MP Sony Cyber-shot camera. Model # DCS-F717.
