

For this set of sculptured nails I have used natural pink and white acrylic.

Greeted and thanked my model for her time and for being my hand model. We both sanitized and washed our hands. Prepped the nails by pushing back the cuticles, and removed the shine using 180 grit file.

I removed the dust with a nylon brush and I applied primer sparingly and let it dry.

I applied black forms to 6 fingers (pinkie, ring, and middle fingers on both hands) and gold forms on both the index & thumbs.

Applied the pink ball first in a one ball method to all the nails.

Went back and applied the white in a one ball method to eliminate shadows.

Waited for them dry before I shaped them with 100/180 grit file.

I cleaned the underside of the nails with an e-file using a diamond cone bit.

I removed the dust and buffed with an orange buffer and then a softer buffer.

I applied clear polish to the nails and let them air dry.

Applied orange scented oil to the cuticles and then a hand cream.

I polished 2 nails with a beautiful red polish.

I used a digital camera made by Cannon, Model: Power Shot SD630.
